Terms of Office

The term of service for each DDC member shall be 3 years. The initial term of service of each member of the first Commission shall be determined at the time of appointment such that the terms of services of approximately 1/3 of the total number of Commissioners shall terminate each year for the first 3 years. Commissioners may be reappointed and may serve two consecutive terms. The chair of the Commission will be the Downtown Development Director.
