## Tennis Baseball Rules

### Organization -

1. **NO** less than 7 with a maximum of 14 on each team.
2. Participants must turn 16 on or before August 1 of present season. All participants 16 must have parents sign medical release form.
3. The entry fee is \$200.00 per team and does include tennis balls.
4. Each team must have matching jerseys with numbers.
5. People may not play with more than one team within the same league during the same season.
6. Anyone playing on a team must be listed on the team roster and must have signed the release form.
7. Each team must have their own score keeper who sits with the opposing score keeper, so the score can be verified each inning. **Home team** will be the official book for the game.

### Game Rules –

1. A game consists of 7 innings. However a complete stopped due to weather will be official after **3** innings.
2. 7 players maximum on the field.
3. Time limit will be 1 hour and 15 minutes. No new inning will start with 5 minutes or less left in the time limit. However the inning must be completed if the home team is losing.
4. Teammates pitch to their own team.
5. Each batter is allowed 6 pitches after the 6 pitch the batter is automatically out. No walks
6. No Stealing.
7. 4 homeruns an inning per team afterwards they will be ruled a double.
8. Mercy Rule: 20 runs after 6 innings of play.
9. Pegs are only made to 1<sup>st</sup> and home. 1 base only after a missed peg. Any intent to intentionally hurt a base runner will result in the base runner being ruled safe and possibly dismissal from the for the defensive player.
10. A batted ball not going past the pitcher will be ruled a foul ball.
11. No **metal** spikes allowed.
12. No bats will be allowed with a barrel bigger than 2 ¼.

**Any rules not specifically defined will be at the judgment of the umpire and/or the City of Anderson Parks & Recreation Department.**

## **CONDUCT:**

The Field Supervisor or umpire(s) will warn anyone not following these rules. A second offense means the individual(s) will be asked to leave and should they not leave, the proper authorities will be contacted.

1. Players, coaches and parents must at all times display a manner that exhibits sportsmanship and good will.
2. No profanity or abusive language will be allowed at any time on city property.
3. Any discussion on the field will involve only one coach, and officials present.
4. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the premises. Any person found to be under the influence, will be asked to leave the area.
5. The use of all tobacco products will be prohibited during the game. One warning will be issued before ejection. Repeated offenses will result in suspension.
6. The umpire is in control of the game. In the event a team fails to respect the umpire's authority or decisions, the umpire is instructed to forfeit the game to the other team after one warning has been given that such action will be taken.
7. If a player, coach, or manager is put out of the game, he may be seated in the stands. If he continues to argue or show unsportsmanlike conduct, he will be asked to leave the field. If he does not leave, the game will be forfeited.
8. Any coach or player ejected from a game will automatically be suspended for the following game as well. A second offense will result in an immediate suspension. A hearing will be scheduled at the Recreation Department Office. The coach or player will not be allowed to play or coach until a hearing is held. The results of this hearing will determine eligibility for the remainder of the season.

## **RAIN-OUT POLICY:**

In case of rain on a scheduled game day, the decision will not be made until after 3:30pm. To find out the status of a game, you may call 226-2489 or 231-2234. This information may also be obtained from the Internet at [www.cityofandersonsc.com](http://www.cityofandersonsc.com). If rain, comes after 5:00pm; a decision will be made, at the field by the umpires and/or field supervisor. The rescheduling of ballgames sometimes deals with the number of games that are already scheduled during that week. All games are rescheduled if at all possible. On occasion some games are not due to the time of the season when the game is rained out. Please remember that our rain patterns are sketchy at times – if you are not sure, please go to the field to avoid forfeits
