

### Conduct:

Anyone not following these rules will be warned by the Field Supervisor. A second offense means the individual(s) will be asked to leave and should they not leave, the proper authorities will be contacted.

1. Players, coaches and parents must at all times display a manner that exhibits sportsmanship and good will.
2. No profanity or abusive language will be allowed at any time on City property.
3. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the premises. Any person found to be under the influence will be asked to leave the area.
4. Any discussion on the field will involve only one coach, and officials present.
5. The use of all tobacco products will be prohibited during the game. One warning will be issued before ejections. Repeated offenses will result in suspension.
6. The umpire is in control of the game. In the event a team fails to respect the umpire's authority or decisions, the umpire is instructed to forfeit the game to the other team after one warning has been given that such actions will be taken.
7. If a player, coach, or manager is put out of the game, he may be seated in the stands. If he continues to argue or show unsportsmanlike conduct, he will be asked to leave the field. If he does not leave, the game will be forfeited.
8. Any coach or player ejected from a game will automatically be suspended for the following game. A second offense will result in an immediate suspension. A hearing will be scheduled at the Recreation Department Office. The coach or player will not be allowed to play or coach until a hearing is held. The results of this hearing will determine eligibility for the remainder of the season.
