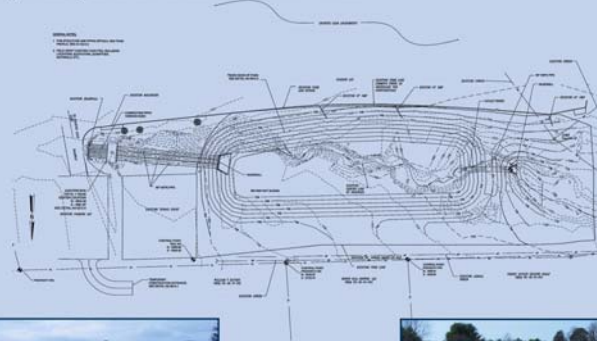


Prior Conditions



Main Street Stormwater Project

This project included the construction of an approximate one-acre stormwater detention pond, including pond outlet and emergency spillway, three 60-inch HDPE pond inlet pipes, an energy dissipating concrete junction box and floor block energy dissipators. The detention pond was designed to control and accommodate the existing runoff from over 100 urban acres, in an effort to attenuate the erosive characteristics of the water quantity and to enhance the water quality downstream. The volume of stormwater runoff had eroded the weak soil banks along a drainage ditch that channeled water into a stream.
